#### Chas Burke

Artist

Chas Burke is a Durham Visual Artist as well as a clarinetist with the Durham Chamber Orchestra. He has done studies at the Bachelor and Masters level at the University of Western Ontario respectively, where he also taught clarinet in studio and class settings as well as conducting the University of

Western Ontario Band.

He has studied Classical Drawing for five years with Pauline Bradshaw – a protégé of John Angel who started the school of Realist Art in West Toronto. He also studied Impressionism with Louis Griffel - head of the Cape Cod School of Art

From his various studies he has consolidated a system

whereby colour is informed by sound.

He uses the principles, structures and progressions of Johan Sebastian Bach to determine the seven colours to be found in any given painting to ensure harmonious balance and blend of colours.


## **Social Media Instructions**

Hi all. I know some of you are unsure how to share information posted in the OAA Facebook account. Sometimes you may not see the posts in your feed, so you might have to go to the OAA page and take it from there.

In Facebook, search Oshawa Art Association. Your screen might be slightly different, but you should see this. Click on Oshawa Art Association to bring you to the home page.




Again, your screen might be different, but you should see something like the following picture. First make sure you are FOLLOWING the OAA. Then if you do not see any recent posts, click the Posts button. It might be on the side as in this picture or on the top of your page. Phones and computers have a different layout, but all the information should be there.



If you scroll down to the bottom of the post, you will see "Like," "Comment", "Share". Click on the Share button. (don't be afraid to Like and Comment as well!)



When you click on the Share button, you will get a menu similar to the next picture. This gives you the options on how to share. The highlighted option Share Now, will immediately share it on your own newsfeed and your friends will see it. The second option Share to Feed, also shares it to your feed but you will have the option to give it a description if you choose. The other options are pretty self-explanatory.



#### **OAA Sharing Place**

If you are a member of the group OAA Sharing Place, you will see a lot of our posts in there, but they are not shareable. The reason is, that group is a private group. It's just the way it was set up. But, if you see a post in there that you would like to share, go to the Oshawa Art Association page to look for it and follow the instructions above.

#### Instagram

Unfortunately, Instagram does not offer a sharing feature. You can SEND a post to people in your friends list, but you cannot easily share it to your feed. The way I do it is, I take a screen shot of the picture, then post it is if it is my own picture. You then must include your own description and hashtags as it does not transfer with a screen shot.

Remember that social media is our main way of advertising and communicating our events. So please share as much as you can to get the work out there! Thank you for your help!
