### President's Message

The combined Official Opening of The OAA Inc. Gallery 67, Workshop Space, and Partnership Event for the O'Neill Choir was very successful. Donations to help with the cost of their trip to the prestigious Carnegie Hall in New York raised \$1,300. Further acknowledgment, and thanks to Aleks Nickolic, Eileen Myers, Jeffrey Snape, Karen Coyle for all their organizational efforts, and, all other OAA volunteers that helped make the evening a success. A special thank you to Regional Chair, John Henry, a longtime supporter of Arts in the Oshawa Community, for taking time from his busy schedule to come to this Special Event.

There have been recent developments since this successful event. On Monday, February 25th, 2019, I was contacted by the owner of 50 Richmond Street, Oshawa, ON who donated space to the OAA Inc. for Gallery 67 and workshops. He had received a call from his Hydro provider for the donated space, and after having his provider verify and check for any issues (none were found), he informed me that the OAA Inc. owed him significant Hydro bills. The Gallery 67, Unit #120, Hydro bill is \$2,205.49 and, for Unit #119 the amount is \$2,030.68, for a combined total of \$4,236.17. This amount was up to the billing date of February 6th, 2019. The owner has requested payment by the OAA Inc. Based on these substantial Hydro costs, the OAA Inc. can not justify continuing on with these two donated units. I contacted the current Board/Officer members, most were in agreement, and on February 27th, 2019 I gave the owner 30 days notice to vacate the premises. After giving notice, I also contacted Councilor Rick Kerr, as he was instrumental in finding this location for us, had knowledge of our arrangements with the owner and, as courtesy for all the support from the City of Oshawa. The OAA Inc. will vacate both Units (#120 & #119) by March 27th, 2019. There may be a further request for payment from the landlord for his outstanding Hydro Bill from billing date February 6th, 2019 to March 27th, 2019.

As your elected President, it is my responsibility to look at the whole of the OAA Inc. and make necessary and sometimes difficult decisions including, management of the OAA finances. The Board of Directors discussed in length this issue at our Board Meeting March 6<sup>th</sup> and all Directors supported this decision.

To view any changes to the Life Drawing and Open Studio locations and classes, please check back on the OAA Inc. website for current updates.

This brings us to the upcoming elections on March 13th,2019. The OAA Inc. has added the following positions to the available Board of Directors openings:

- 1st Vice-president, (Jeffrey Snape has resigned his positions)
- Secretary (due to unexpected health issues in the family)
