Colour, texture, surface experimentation are key elements of his style. His subject matter is varied as he considers form and process more important than subject matter.

William 'Kelly' Antonichuk



William "Kelly" Antonichuk is passionate about his Soapstone Carvings and the expressions he sees within each stone. He is quick to say that each piece "Speaks to me" or "I see this." Each carving uniquely captures this artistically creative, interactive medium, shared spiritual process. Kelly began carving under the influence of Floyd Kuptana, a prominent Canadian Inuit artist. Together they shared the backyard of a friend, Bob Salter, in September 2017.

From their meetings, Kelly went on to complete many Series of Carving Collections. He uses a variety of hand files, saws, drill bits, sandpaper, finishing materials, and he embeds gems, tusks, marbles, bear claws, porcupine quills and teeth from all over the world into his carvings. The carving medium he prefers is Brazilian Soapstone.

Kelly was honoured to have one of his pieces "My Fan Club" accepted into The 50th Annual Juried Art Exhibition at The

In April 2019, at the 51st Annual Juried Art Exhibition at The Robert McLaughlin Gallery, Kelly received a Certificate of Recognition for "My Fan Club II" in the SCULPTURE / THREE DIMENSIONAL Category. Kelly's work will be on display at the Fall Camp Samac Show.



Abstract Art Spiel Workshop


